ESSEX STEAM TRAIN AND RIVERBOAT: 1 Railroad Avenue, Essex

Starting from the historic 1892 Essex train station, the steam locomotive pulls vintage coaches through a 30-minute, 12-mile narrated trip through New England small towns and wild spaces. At the end of the line at the Deep River Landing, passengers with the combined Train and Riverboat Ticket will board the *Becky Thatcher* riverboat for a 75-minute cruise on the Connecticut River. Upon arrival back at the dock passengers board the waiting train for the 30-minute return trip to Essex Station. Those not going on the riverboat simply remain on the train for a return trip to Essex station. (No alcohol. Limited food and beverages available in first class only on train and boat)

The museum is a short walk from the Essex Corinthian Yacht Club, the center of the Reunion gatherings. Riverboat cruise tickets include museum admission so you can combine a visit to the museum before or after your cruise. No food or beverages are available on the boats, but you may bring your own. A bathroom is available on RiverQuest only.
